The funding required for UBI amounts to approximately **16% of current per-capita income in New York State** (average monthly income  $\approx$  USD \$6,250). This level is fiscally feasible and will significantly reduce inefficient, overlapping, and high-administrative-cost welfare programs.

##### **2. Universal Free Basic Healthcare**

Access to medical care when ill is a **basic survival necessity**, not a privilege.

Currently, approximately **5% of New York State residents lack health insurance**, which causes individual suffering, increases uncompensated care, burdens public finance, and undermines social stability.

Universal free basic healthcare will:

- Eliminate the reality of avoiding medical treatment due to cost
- Reduce systemic healthcare inefficiencies
- Improve public health outcomes and long-term social stability

- **Revitalize Manufacturing:** Manufacturing is a fundamental necessity and the backbone of the real economy
- **Full-Scale Infrastructure Development:** Housing, roads, bridges, subways, parks, and public transit
- **Increase GDP and Per-Capita Assets:** Strengthen New York’s global competitiveness
- **Advance Education, Technology, and Industrial Chains:** Build long-term productivity

New York must not only be wealthy—it must be **sustainably strong**.

#### **VII. Social Governance and Institutional Reform (Key Directions)**

- Eliminate minimum wage mandates, with UBI guaranteeing basic living standards
- Abolish unreasonable property taxes
- Implement a unified tax rate, where higher income still results in higher tax paid
- Rationalize and integrate welfare programs to reduce waste
- Strengthen policing and the justice system
- Enforce gun prohibition and drug prohibition to protect public safety and health
- Build **6,000** free, 24-hour public restrooms statewide
- Government responsibility for sanitation in all public areas
- Fully develop free-market and real-economy activities
- Conduct a comprehensive review and correction of unreasonable laws and regulations

#### 四、首要政策：全民基本收入与全民免费基本医保

##### 1. 全民基本收入 (Universal Basic Income, UBI)

- \$1000/人/月 (\$33/人/天)
- 无条件, 覆盖所有纽约人

\$1000/月是现实社会中的**贫困线水平**。

UBI 实施后, 每一个纽约人都将**不再低于贫困线**, 纽约将实现**零贫困**。

UBI 的资金来源约为纽约州现有人均收入的 **16%** (人均月收入约 \$6250), 在财政上完全可行, 并将显著减少低效、重复、管理成本极高的传统福利体系支出。

##### 2. 全民免费基本医疗保障

目前纽约州仍有约 **5%** 的居民没有**医疗保险**, 这不仅造成个人痛苦, 也导致医疗系统坏账、财政补贴与社会风险。

全民免费基本医保将:

- 显著提升公共健康与社会稳定

#### 五、“六个零”社会目标 (Six Zeros)

- 加强警力与司法, 保障社会安全
- 禁枪、禁毒, 维护公共安全与健康
- 建设 6000 个 24 小时免费公共厕所
- 政府负责公共卫生清扫
- 充分发展自由市场与实体经济
- 全面审查并修正不合理法律法规
